C.E.M. CERTIFICATE

This certificate must be submitted online before arrival of the Lot at Park Paddocks or at the duplicate or outside standing.

The Vendor or his/her Agent is solely responsible for the accuracy of this certificate.

To be completed by a Veterinary Surgeon:

Two clitoral swabs should be taken at least 7 days apart. One swab should be dated **WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE SALE (i.e. from June 10th onwards)** and the other swab must have been taken after the last date of covering. Swabs must be submitted to a Laboratory approved by the Horserace Betting Levy Board (HBLB) in the United Kingdom or to National Approved Laboratories in all other countries and be cultured under both aerobic and microaerophilic conditions or tested by PCR.

On theand (Dates, see above) swabs were obtained from the **CLITORIS (FOSSA AND SINUSES)** of the mare..... (Name) and submitted for bacteriological examination for C.E.M. at the Laboratory and cultured under both aerobic and microaerophilic conditions or tested by PCR. The results were negative. Neither *Klebsiella pneumoniae* nor *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* were isolated.
