NOTICE TO VENDORS

- ENTRY FORM** Please make your entries via the Tattersalls eCommerce website (www.tattersalls.com), where the Terms and Conditions and the Vendor's Declaration are available to download. **Tattersalls must receive all entries by Friday 30th June, at the latest.**
- FEES (see Condition of Sale 3)** For this Sale, entry and withdrawal fees are:
 - Entry fees* (See Condition of Sale 3.1) The entry fee for the Ascot September Yearling Sale is £600 for each Lot catalogued. This includes charges for compilation of Sales details and printing. This fee will be debited to your Sales account. The minimum selling price for the Ascot September yearling Sale is £800.
 - WITHDRAWAL FEES (See Condition of Sale 3.5) LOTS WITHDRAWN FROM THESE SALES WITHOUT A VETERINARY CERTIFICATE TO TATTERSALLS' SATISFACTION ON OR AFTER MONDAY 17th JULY WILL INCUR A WITHDRAWAL FEE OF £300**
- VENDOR OWNERSHIP** (see Condition of Sale 9.12) Please refer to this Condition to see what is required where there has been any change in the ownership of a Lot between the date of the Sales Entry Form and the time at which the Lot is put up for auction.
- REGISTRATION COSTS** Where costs are incurred by a Purchaser in registering a Lot as catalogued or in obtaining all required registration papers for a Lot, these costs will be the responsibility of the Vendor. Vendors of Lots coming from overseas must apply to their Stud Book Authority for export certificates to be sent to Weatherbys.
- STRANGLES CLEARANCE CERTIFICATES** (see Condition of Sale 8.4) Tattersalls reserve the right to refuse any Lot entry to Tattersalls' premises in accordance with Condition of Sale 8.4.. In accordance with the Sales Documentation Notice, please ensure that a Strangles Health Declaration is delivered to Tattersalls on or before the arrival of the Lot.

6. **INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS** All Lots offered for sale must be vaccinated against Equine Influenza. Flu Vaccinations – Two primary injections to be given not less than twenty-one and not more than ninety-two days apart. A booster injection should be given not less than one hundred and fifty and not more than two hundred and fifteen days apart. Thereafter, one injection should be given annually. Vaccinations must be entered in the passport. Announcements will be made from the Rostrum, where this procedure has not been fulfilled.
NB All horses may not enter racecourse stables until 7 days after receiving the second primary injection for vaccination until the next booster is due. If boosters have not been given by the appropriate time the horses cannot enter racecourses
7. **INSURANCE** Vendors attention is drawn to Condition of Sale 8. We strongly recommend that insurance cover be arranged against mortality and theft.
8. **Blood Testing** Blood testing is available at the option of the purchaser as described under Condition of Sale 27 (Drugs) & Condition of Sale 28 (Piroplasmiasis).
9. **MICROCHIPS** All Lots offered for sale must be microchipped prior to going through the Sale Ring and the passport updated with the appropriate Stud Book Authority.
