NOTICE TO VENDORS

1. **ENTRY FORM**

Please make your entries via the Tattersalls eCommerce website, www.tattersalls.com, where the Terms and Conditions are available to download. **Tattersalls must receive all entries by Monday 10th September.**

2. **FEES** (See Condition of Sale 3)

(a) Entry fees (See Condition of Sale 3.1)

The entry fee for this Sale will be £650 for each Lot catalogued on the first three days of Sale; £325 for each Lot catalogued on the Thursday; and £200 for each Lot catalogued on the Friday. This includes charges for compilation of Sales' details and printing and will be debited to your Sales account and includes a 5% levy as a contribution towards the BHA/TBA Inward Buyers Scheme for the financing of visits by overseas Purchasers to the Sales. The minimum selling price at this Sale is 800 guineas.

(b) Withdrawal fees (see Condition of Sale 3.4)

- Lots withdrawn without a veterinary certificate to Tattersalls' satisfaction on or after Friday 21st September and up to and including Thursday 11th October will incur a withdrawal fee of £250;
- Those Lots similarly withdrawn on or after Friday 12th October and up to and including Tuesday 23rd October, a withdrawal fee of £500;
- And those Lots withdrawn thereafter, a withdrawal fee of £1,000.
- For those Lots catalogued on the Thursday and Friday, withdrawal fees are as before save that Lots withdrawn from Wednesday 24th October up to time of sale will incur a fee of £500.
- **Veterinary certificates must be received by Tattersalls within 28 days after the last day of sale.**

3. **VENDOR OWNERSHIP** (See Condition of Sale 9.10)

Please refer to this Condition to see what is required where there has been any change in the ownership of a Lot between the date of the Sales Entry Form and the time at which the Lot is put up for auction.

4. **REGISTRATION COSTS**

Where costs are incurred by a Purchaser in registering a Lot as catalogued or in obtaining all required registration papers for a Lot, these costs will be the responsibility of the Vendor. Vendors of Lots coming from overseas must apply to their Stud Book Authority for export certificates to be sent to Weatherbys.

5. **CEM, EVA DOCUMENTS and STRANGLES CLEARANCE CERTIFICATES** (See Condition of Sale 8.4)

Tattersalls reserve the right to refuse any Lot entry to Tattersalls' premises in accordance with Condition of Sale 8.4. Where a CEM and/or EVA and/or Strangles Clearance Certificate are required (see your online account or the Sales Documentation Notice).

Please ensure that the appropriate documentation is submitted online or delivered to Tattersalls at least 10 days before the arrival of the Lot at Park Paddocks, as failure to do so may result in your Lot(s) being refused entry or withdrawn.

6. **INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS**

Please ensure that flu vaccinations are up-to-date at time of Sale and that details are recorded in the horse's passport. If Tattersalls are notified by the Purchaser within 21 days after which the Lot was sold that flu vaccinations were not up-to-date at the time of Sale, Tattersalls reserve the right to charge the Vendor any costs incurred and may deduct these costs from Sale proceeds.

7. **INSURANCE**

Vendors' attention is drawn to Condition of Sale 8. We strongly recommend that insurance cover is arranged against mortality and theft.

8. **DRUGS**

Vendors should note that horses sold **IN AND OUT of Training** will be subject to post-Sale testing for anabolic steroids and non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs. Please refer to the revised Conditions of Sale 23 and 25.

9. **PERMANENT IMPORT TESTING**

Vendors should note that Tattersalls may be notified by the British Horseracing Authority (BHA) that a Lot requires to pass a BHA Import test to be trained and/or raced in Great Britain (see Condition of Sale 24).

10. **PIROPLASMOSIS**

Vendors should note that all horses sold will be subject to testing for Piroplasmosis (unless described without qualification as positive or doubtful for Piroplasmosis) following sale (see Condition of Sale 26).

11. **REPOSITORY**

Tattersalls offer a voluntary Repository in which Vendors may at their discretion place pre-Sale X-rays, video endoscopies and other stipulated information. Use of the Repository will be subject to the terms, conditions and procedures relating to the Repository, the Repository Rules which may be viewed on our website, www.tattersalls.com.

12. **STABLING (Newmarket Consignors)**

Wherever possible all Lots will be allocated stabling at Park Paddocks. However, should Newmarket-based Consignors wish their Lots to be stabled at home they should notify the Bloodstock Department when making entries.
