RECLAMATION (IRE), 1 race at 3 years; dam of **Rythmique (IRE)**, 2 races at 2 and 3 years in France and placed third in Prix Pénélope, Saint-Cloud, **Gr.3**.

Her Grace (IRE), unraced; dam of **LIMINI (IRE)**, 4 races at home and in France; also 4 races over hurdles including Dawn Run Mares Novice Hurdle, Cheltenham.

NIGHTLARK (IRE), won 1 race at 3 years and £11,329 and placed 7 times; dam of winners.

Radamanto (IRE), 1 race in Italy; also 1 race over jumps at 4 years in Italy and placed third in Premio Criterium d'Inverno Hurdle, Rome.

Overplay, won 2 races at 2 and 3 years and placed second in Athasi Stakes, Curragh, **Gr.3** and fourth in Irish 1000 Guineas, Curragh, **Gr.1**; dam of winners.
