BOLD AND BLACK (GB), won 8 races at 2 to 6 years in France and £53,145 and placed 14 times.

CARBURTON (GB), won 6 races at 2, 4 and 5 years and £35,345 and placed 6 times.

WILL IT FIGURE (GB), won 2 races at 4 years in Hong Kong and £48,734 and placed 4 times.
